Rallies, Committee Meetings and News

Next Rally: 2nd May 2010

Committee Meeting: Thursday 27th May 2010 @ 7.30pm



Rally Reminders: All riders must have a parent / guardian present with them at ALL times during the rally & at WPC events. Parents are reminded that while the riders are under the tuition of an instructor in class times, they are not to approach the instructors or the riders.

Riders also need to be aware that if you are late, or need to leave a class / rally early, you must advise the instructor and excuse yourself. You then must notify the President or DC.

Cross Country: There are to be NO CARS on the Cross Country Course, only the first aid car!

Un-mounted Rally attendance: Riders must be in full uniform and helping at the rally to gain rally attendance. Helping includes selling raffle tickets, setting up/packing up, etc & \$10.00 rally fee applies.

First Aid and accidents at rallies: If any rider falls or is injured, this MUST be reported to the First Aid Officer immediately, no matter how big or small the injury is. Any rider that hits there head upon a fall must be monitored for 1 hour by the First Aid Officer before being able to remount.

WPNEC OUTSIDE OF RALLIES: Just a reminder if you wish to use the WPNEC outside of rallies, you must contact the centre to book and pay a \$15.00 facility fee.





Mounted and Un-Mounted Rally Fee's and Shows!

Mounted rally fee's are \$20.00 per rally & must be paid upon handing in your card – **BEFORE YOU RIDE!**

Un-mounted rally fees are \$10.00 per rally. Un-mounted riders have unlimited access to theory and classes in progress during the day. If the rider is issued a horse to ride during the course of the rally (as authorized by parent/guardian and the DC or President) they then must pay the full rally fee of \$20.00

If you do not advise the president of DC VIA EMAIL the FRIDAY WEEK BEFORE the rally then you are still liable to pay the \$20.00 rally fee to help cover the costs of instructors. If the club is advised of your non-attendance, we can accommodate groups & instructors ahead of the rally.

NO SHOW rally fees are to be paid in FULL prior to riding at the next rally.

Please do not advise of your non-attendance via a friend, face book or when passing the DC, President or Secretary outside of Pony Club. PLEASE EMAIL ONLY!!!!

PCAV / WPC 2010-2011 RENEWAL

- Renewals for the 2010-2011 periods are due no later then the MAY 30th rally. Forms will be available to collect at the May rally and are also located on the WPC website.
- \$90.00 fee per rider covers the PCAV Insurance, to Central Zone and to the WPC.
 - \$210.00 fee covers the riders rally fees up until June 2011.

This new payment system was passed at the April committee meeting to try and reduce the amount of money that the club is losing due to riders not turning up to rallies and not advising anyone of their absence. We will also now have the opportunity to plan things in advance due to having the funds, whether it be hiring out the arena or getting in a specialist instructor.

Please note that we would still appreciate it if you could advise us at your earliest convenience possible if you are not attending pony club as we can make adjustments to the way we run that particular rally.

Rider Groups

Carol & Wayne have reviewed the groups and there have been changes made. These will be effective of the May 2nd & May 30th rally. Once riders have renewed for the 2010/2011 season, they will be reviewed again prior to the JULY rally. Theory groups have also changed due to rider certificates.

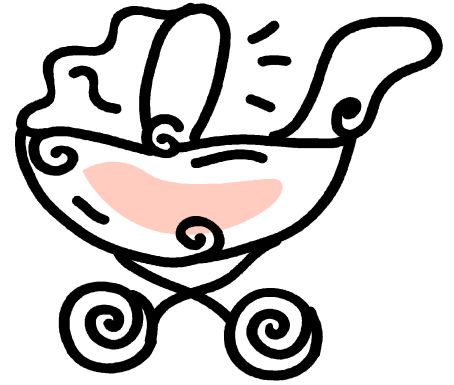
