**REMINDER:** The September rally will be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend of September due to Friends of Werribee Park Horse Trials (Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 5<sup>th</sup>). Helpers are needed for this event on the Saturday for Dressage penciling. It is a great way to learn what judges look at when judging a dressage test. Please email Aimee if you are interested in helping.

**Cross Country:** There are to be NO CARS on the Cross Country Course, only the first aid car!

**Un-mounted Rally attendance:** Riders must be in full uniform and helping at the rally to gain rally attendance. Helping includes selling raffle tickets, setting up/packing up, etc.

**First Aid and accidents at rallies:** If any rider falls or is injured, this MUST be reported to the First Aid Officer immediately, no matter how big or small the injury is. Any rider that hits their head upon a fall must be monitored for 1 hour by the First Aid Officer before being able to remount.

**WPNEC OUTSIDE OF RALLIES:** Just a reminder if you wish to use the WPNEC outside of rallies, you must contact the centre to book and pay a \$15.00 facility fee.

## PCAV Cards

PCAV Cards at rallies!!

Just a reminder to all members regarding PCAV cards at rallies.

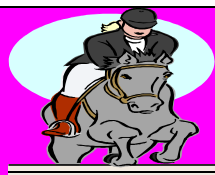
- All cards must be handed in before you ride so all riders can be signed in at the rally. Any cards not handed in prior to riding, riders may be marked as **ABSENT**, as they are not on the attendance sheet.
- When signing in at the rally, please advise the **COMPETITION NAME** of your horse, not the paddock name. EG: your horse name is Bobby, but when you compete, his competition name is Regal Fantasia. You need to then sign your horse in as Regal Fantasia as that is the name of the horse that you will be graded as, and noted as when entering competitions.
- Collection of cards at the end of the rally. **ALL** cards need to be collected by 3.45 pm. As the theory class is from 2.55 – 3.25, please do not complete theory, wash your horse, load them on the float, then come to the clubrooms at 4 pm to collect cards. Please collect them as soon as your theory class is completed. All cards will now be locked up at 3.45 and you will have to collect them at the following rally.

It is the rider's responsibility to ensure cards are completed correctly before attending any competitions. There is also an information sheet located on the club website on rider cards & how to ensure they are correctly completed before going to a competition.

Last weekend saw the Grade 3 & 4 Interzone Team State Horse Trials (which I am on the organizing committee for also!) held at WPNEC! And what a great weekend!! The weather astounded us, and was perfect both days! Saturday was dressage & Cross Country, with Sunday the Showjumping. Werribee had 1 rider in the Grade 3 section, Mel M. Mel was 2nd in the dressage, with both a clear on Cross Country & Showjumping. Unfortunately, the rest of her team had some problems, which moved them out of a placing. The Grade 4 riders from the club were Emma & Sam B, Deanna R & Jaime S. There were some refusals on Cross Country & rails on the showjumping, but all riders had a great weekend riding in there teams, & they all did a great job on an extremely challenging course, even if they did have home ground advantage! There were falls (no injuries), refusals and run outs, which made the scoring tough for the teams. The final result was North Eastern Zone taking out the perpetual Shield as the winning zone. The Central Zone team Grade 4 team, The Junior Pro's, came in 4th overall for the Zone. Let's hope 2011 brings in lots of Werribee riders to the event so we can help try to take out the Interzone shield!

Bacchus Marsh Horse Trials also saw nearly 20 riders from Werribee out competing, and some great results! Open Grade 2 saw Mel M 2nd in her dressage. In Grade 3 Amy L came in 2nd overall. Open Grade 4 saw Jess S finish 5th. Then the Grade 5's cleaned up with Olivia C 5th, Taylor T 4th, and Gabby 1st after dressage! Well done riders! There were some great results!!

Erin Allison has also moved up, now competing in Grade 3 Dressage for the BEDS series. Good luck Erin for the rest of the series!

## **WERRIBEE P.C: WHO DOES WHAT?**

### **D.C - WAYNE CUTHBERT**

**Rider grading/re-grading** - Horse Trials, Combined Training, Dressage & Showjumping. Riders can be graded after 2 rallies on the mount that they wish to have graded.

**PCAV Rider Cards** - signs riders for attendance

**Rider groups** - works with the President on rider groups.

### **PRESIDENT - CAROL BRADLEY**

**Meetings** - manages the bi-monthly Club meetings.

**Parents Rally roster** - If you are rostered on & will not be at the rally, you need to find a replacement for that day & advise the President that you have found a replacement. The yearly rally roster is also located on the club website.

**Rider groups** - works with the D.C on rider groups.

**Dispute resolution** - liaises with parents / instructors / riders with any disputes within the club.

*You will need to contact either the President or DC if you are not riding at the rally, or wish to have your place in your riding group reviewed.*

### **VICE PRESIDENT - CHERI SLIPAIS**

**Rider Certificates** – for riders wishing to complete there PCAV D, D\*, C, C\*, K certificates, etc. Certificate forms are located on the club website, & booking forms need to be given to the Vice President for Certificates to be booked in. All homework needs to be sighted by the Vice President also.

**SECRETARY – AIMEE CUTHBERT**

**Club administration** – rider administration duties. EG: rider has lost PC card & needs a replacement. Also signing rider cards for attendance.

**TREASURER – JANET TEAGUE**

**Club finances** – any financial details within the club, eg: payment for rally fees, horse trials, State event entries, club renewals, payment for uniforms, etc.

EG: You need to book in for a C Certificate. See the Vice President. You need a new WPC Jumper. See the uniform coordinator.

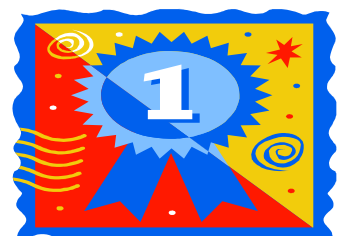
This will ensure you receive a correct answer at all times and if they don't know, they will find out for you and contact you back.

**REGISTERING YOUR PROPERTY WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PRIMARY INDUSTRY ( DPI ) WITH A PROPERTY IDENTIFICATION CODE - PIC**

TO ALL MEMBERS AND CLUBS

As of 1st. July 2010 all properties with horses have to be registered with the Department of Primary Industries ( DPI ) .

To apply for a PIC number ( Property Identification Code ) number all you have to do is :- )

Google DPI Victoria PIC page and follow the links to down load an application form or phone the number 1800 678 779 for more information.

Forms are also available from any Department of Primary Industry office.

If your property is already registered with a PIC for cattle, sheep or another form of livestock, you won't need to have a new number but you must inform the Department that there is a horse / horses kept on the property.
