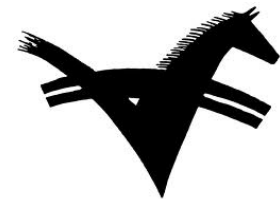

WHO DOES WHAT

Rider grading/re-grading– DC. Grading for Horse Trials, Combined Training, Dressage & Showjumping. Riders can be graded after 2 rallies on the mount that they wish to have graded. **DC – WAYNE CUTHBERT**

Rider Groups– DC/President. Groups at rallies. This includes if you are not riding at the rally, you need to notify either of these people. **DC – WAYNE CUTHBERT / PRESIDENT - CHERI SLIPAIS**

Parents Rally roster– President. If you are rostered on & will not be at the rally, you need to find a replacement for that day. **PRESIDENT - CHERI SLIPAIS**

Finances –Treasurer. Any financial details within the club, eg: payment for rally fees, horse trials, State event entries, etc. **TREASURER- JANET TEAGUE / ASST TREASURER - MAREE HUTTON**

Rider Certificates– Vice President. Riders wishing to complete there PCAV certificates. Certificate forms are located on the club website. **VICE PRESIDENT CAROL BRADLEY**

Administration– Secretary. Administration duties for the club, eg: rider has lost a card & needs a replacement. **SECRETARY -AIMEE CUTHBERT**

Contact details for all executive committee members are also located on the Werribee PC website.

Uniforms including saddle blankets, polo tops, jumpers, PCAV rule books– uniform coordinator **KAREN BROOKS**

RALLY REMINDERS

Rallies: All riders must have a parent / guardian present with them at **ALL** times during the rally & at WPC events. Parents are reminded that while the riders are under the tuition of an instructor in class times, they are not to approach the instructors or the riders.

Riders also need to be aware that if you are late, or need to leave a class / rally early, you must advise the instructor and excuse yourself. You then must notify the President or DC

Cross Country: There are to be **NO CARS** on the Cross Country Course, only the **first aid** car!
This is for the safety of horses, riders and spectators.

Un-mounted Rally attendance: Riders must be in full uniform and helping at the rally to gain rally attendance. Helping includes selling raffle tickets, setting up/packing up, etc

First Aid and accidents at rallies: If any rider falls or is injured, this **MUST** be reported to the First Aid Officer immediately, no matter how big or small the injury is. Any rider that hits their head upon a fall must be monitored for 1 hour by the First Aid Officer before being able to remount.

WPNEC outside of rallies: Just a reminder if you wish to use the WPNEC outside of rallies, you must contact the centre to book and pay a \$15.00 facility fee

PCAV Fees 2011

Due to administrative reasons, this year, the PCAV have moved the payment date for Clubs from the 1st -15th June to lodge the strength report (renewals), to the 1st – 15th May. Due to the date change, the strength report will be completed at the MAY 1ST RALLY! **This means that riders renewing for the 2011/2012 season will have to have forms returned and payments completed by the MAY 1ST rally to be eligible to ride from July 1st.** The PCAV are setting their fees at the February State Council meeting. Werribee PC 2011/2012 fees will be \$310 for PCAV / WPC fees & 11 instructional rallies for the season.

*Those families with 2 or more riders are eligible for a payment plan

From the PCAV MAD Magazine:

Bylaw 10.5a the State Office must receive a PCAV club member fee for each junior and Associate Club members as follows:

	Period	Applicable to	Due at State Office
Strength Return Period	1 st May to 15 th May	Those wishing to join or renew club membership for the following PCAV year (starting 1st July)	Registration: Online or by mail on or before 15th May. Payment: by mail arriving by the 15th May or any alternate date as determined from time to time by State Council
